# Precautionary Measures

- The HKEAA is implementing a series of precautionary measures during the marking period to ensure health and well-being of examination personnel.



# Precautionary Measures

- Displaying QR code of LeaveHomeSafe at the prominent position in the assessment centres
- Monitoring body temperature of markers before entry to the assessment centres



# Precautionary Measures

- Collecting health declaration forms **each time** markers enter the assessment centres
  - Blank health declaration form will be available at assessment centres and the Other Information Corner of the HKEAA EPO homepage (<http://epo.hkeaa.edu.hk/>)



# Health Declaration Form

- Markers will **NOT** be admitted into the meeting/marking venue of the HKEAA if they
  - are with any of the following symptoms of COVID-19, such as having a fever (body temperature at 38°C or above), symptoms of acute respiratory tract infection (such as a cough or shortness of breath) or sudden loss of sense of taste or smell, etc.

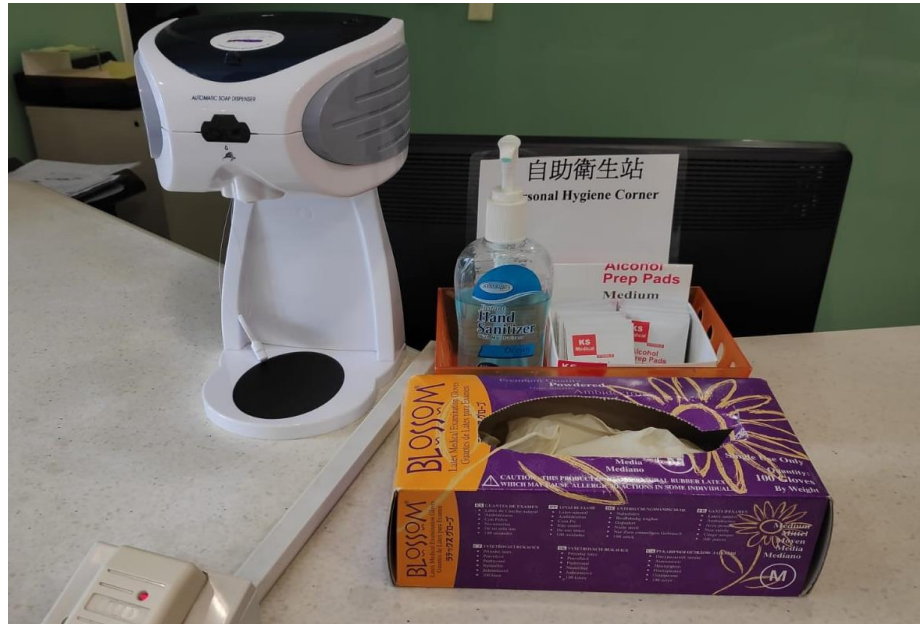
OR

- are undergoing mandatory quarantine that day



# Precautionary Measures

- Alcohol hand sanitizers, wet alcohol tissue and gloves will be available at entrance counters for markers' use



# Precautionary Measures

- Frequent cleaning of workstations, especially devices or areas which are exposed to human touch (such as keyboard, mouse, table top, back of chair, etc.) will be conducted
- Hygiene of common areas particularly toilets, pantries, lift panels, doors and etc., will also be stepped up
- Air conditioning system will be regularly checked and cleaned



# Precautionary Measures

- **NO meal** practice is in place in the assessment centres and use of microwave oven is suspended. Markers are advised to eat some food before coming to assessment centres.
- Ensuring markers wear face masks in the assessment centres, including break rooms, toilets and pantries.
- Monitoring any gatherings or crowds in communal areas of assessment centres and remind markers to practice social distancing when queueing inside toilets and using lift.





# Precautionary Measures

- Sanitizing spray and tissue will also be provided in each floor / assessment zone for cleaning of keyboards and mouse, etc.



# Precautionary Measures

- Installation of additional high partitions in all workstations
