

The Hong Kong Examinations and Assessment Authority (HKEAA) is looking for suitably qualified and experienced Oral Examiners for the speaking tests of GCE / IGCSE Examinations.

**Oral Examiner:**

- 1. Chinese Language (Cantonese and Mandarin)**
- 2. German Language**
- 3. French Language**
- 4. Spanish Language**

**Duties:** To perform the role of an Oral Examiner for the Pearson Edexcel GCE / IGCSE Examination and Cambridge International GCE / IGCSE Examination for the Chinese language and other foreign languages.

**Examination Period:** March to May 2022

**Examination Hours:**

1. Monday to Friday – Evening (1800 - 2200);
2. Saturday, Sunday / Public Holidays – Morning, Afternoon and Evening (0830 – 2200)

**Examination Venue:** HKEAA San Po Kong Office

**Requirements:**

1. An undergraduate or postgraduate degree of the language subject;
2. A Registered Teacher with at least three years' teaching experience;
3. Able to complete tasks accurately and respond positively to guidance; and
4. Good command of spoken and written in English and the language subject.

***\*Preference will be given to applicants who have fulfilled the following requirements:***

1. Pass in the Test of Advanced Proficiency in Putonghua awarded by the HKEAA and/or Grade B, Level 2 or above in the National Putonghua Proficiency Test (PSC) (***For Chinese Language – Mandarin only***);
2. Experience in teaching the GCE / IGCSE course for the language subject; and
3. With Oral Examiner experience in other exams (e.g. HKDSE / GCE / IGCSE) for the language subject.

**Application:**

Applications should be submitted online via the Examination Personnel Online System (<http://epo.hkeaa.edu.hk>) on or before 7 January 2022 (Friday).

Shortlisted applicants will be invited to attend an interview. Applicants not receiving a reply by the end of January 2022 should consider their applicants unsuccessful.
